Every donation brings us closer to financial independence and sustainability — ensuring lasting solutions for those we serve.

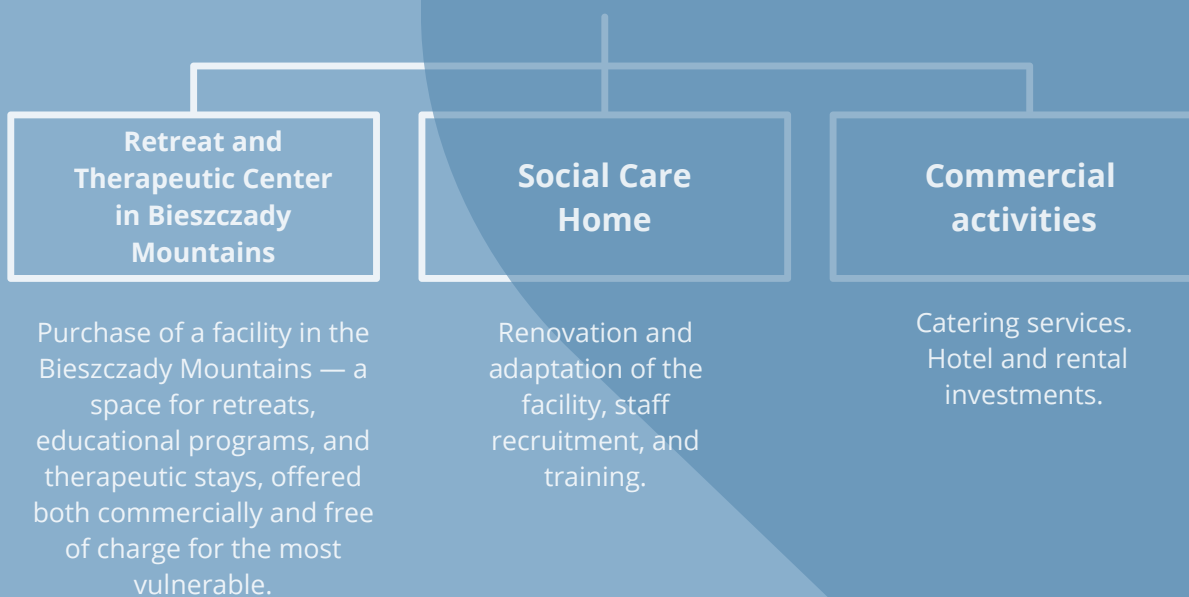

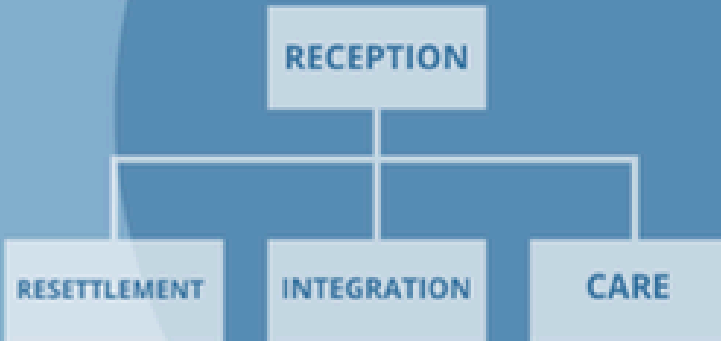
